

All Aussie Stubbied Beers

Stone's Premium Alcoholic Ginger Beer 4.8%

A refreshing, zingy drink with a definite hit of ginger both on the nose and palate that is moderated by a softening sweetness. Stone's Premium Alcoholic Ginger Beer is the perfect way to quench the thirst on a hot summer's day.

Foster's Lager - Australia's Famous Beer (Southbank, VIC) 4.9%

Foster's Lager is Australia's original, full strength lager Created by the Foster Brothers in 1887. This lighter European-style lager became the beer of choice for Australian beer drinkers creating a milestone in brewing history. Foster's Lager is an internationally distributed Australian brand available in more than 150 countries.

Brew Boys Maiden Ale (Regency Park, SA) 4.9%

This beer is a stylish Amber Ale, a well rounded full bodied beer with citrus and floral hop aromas, robust caramel malt with well balanced bitterness.

Bierhaus Hefeweizen (Lobethal Bierhaus, SA) 5.2%

A deep golden wheat beer cloudy in appearance due to the presence of yeast. This beer exhibits strong fruity and vanilla ester flavours.

Bierhaus Pale Ale (Lobethal Bierhaus, SA) 5.2%

A golden copper ale brewed using American style hops to produce high hop bitterness, flavour and aroma. This style is based on extremely popular pale ales that have become a standard in the micro brewing industry.

Bierhaus Red Truck Porter (Lobethal Bierhaus, SA) 5.2%

A dark red brown ale characterised by roasted malt flavour, balanced with subtle hop aroma bitterness. This ale is based on a style originally developed in 18th century London.

Little Creatures Pale Ale (Fremantle, WA) 5.2%

With robust malty flavours and earthy floral aromas, this beer boasts a feisty bitterness with a lingering, crisp finish. This beer's unique flavour comes from the use of whole hop flowers, which contain all the essential oils and acids for a great taste.

Little Creatures Pilsner (Fremantle, WA) 4.6%

This popular pilsner is refreshing and has a very crisp and clean taste. This beer is based on the classically structured European examples that use the finest Saaz hops and a patient fermentation regime.

Little Creatures Bright Ale (Fremantle, WA) 4.5%

A crisp beer with summer fruit aromas, it is brewed with a mix of golden and pale malts. Full flavoured, it is still soft and easy on the palate with a striking golden clarity.

Beez Neez (Matilda Bay, WA) 4.7%

A distinctive beer, Beez Neez is brewed with pure light amber honey, which in addition to its light malty palate, creates a dominating honey aroma and a sweet honey flavour.

Beard and Brau Red Tail (Para Hills, SA) 5.1%

A rich, creamy Amber Ale, this beer has chocolate caramel malt flavours with a strong bitterness that offsets the sweetness, providing a harmonious balance. It is rich and deep red in colour, with a full creamy body.

Steam Exchange India Pale Ale (Goolwa, SA) 5.8%

A heavily hopped, high alcohol beer, with a big malty flavour, this beer is created with traditional ingredients imported specially from the UK, but made right here in SA!

Steam Exchange Truffles (Goolwa, SA) 6.5%

Brewed using unique crystal malts this dessert beer is fortified with the addition of bourbon and has dark chocolate overtones. This black velvety beer is wickedly smooth and leaves a bittersweet aftertaste to savour. Best served chilled. Hand-crafted by brewers who may contain traces of nuts.

Knapstein Lager (Clare Valley, SA) 5.6%

A premium Bavarian style lager, it has a distinctive wine-like balance with an elegant and unparalleled substance and style. The lager has tropical fruit flavours with citrus notes which leap out, while the palate finishes long and cleanly.

James Boags Premium 5%

This beer combines the very best of Tasmania and the Boag brewery and is brewed from the finest quality pilsner malts, creating a crisp, pale lager, which perfectly complements fine food.

James Squire Jack of Spades Porter (Malt Shovel Brewery, NSW) 5%

This beer is rich in colour, while offering a far more delicate complexity than a stout. Roasted barley and wheat, subtle hoppings and a long maturation create hints of malt chocolate, a pillowy head and a light, creamy finish!

James Squire Nine Tales Amber Ale (Malt Shovel Brewery, NSW) 5%

With numerous Australian International Beer Awards under its belt, this ale is defiantly one to try. Hand crafted with a blend of malts, three distinctive hops and 140 year old fermenting ale yeast it has a long, slightly nutty finish.

James Squire Four Wives Pilsener (Malt Shovel Brewery, NSW) 5%

James Squire Pilsener is brewed using Pale and Munich malts, Saaz hops and lager yeast. With a cool fermentation and extended maturation, the result is an authentic brew of sparkling golden brilliance, distinctive floral hop aroma and enticing spicy finish.

Coopers Dark Ale 4.5%

A dark brew full of promise, this beer starts off with a fresh and creamy taste, finishing with a lingering coffee flavour. Conditioned and naturally brewed, it is made using roasted and chocolate malts, giving it a rich dark colour and unique flavour.

Coopers Stout 6.3%

Brewed naturally using a top fermentation method, the unique rich, dark texture comes from specially roasted black malt. With its robust flavour and no additives or preservatives, it's everything a stout should be!

Coopers Sparkling Ale 5.8%

Famous for its cloudy sediment, with a distinctive balance of malt, hops and fruity characters, it is still brewed using the same methods as when it was first made in 1862. This is a beer with history!

Coopers Pale Ale 4.6%

The local classic of the Coopers range, this beer has a distinct fruity character with a secondary fermentation that creates the trademark sediment in this robust-flavoured beer.

Hahn Super Dry 4.6%

With its spicy nose, light golden colour and smooth malty flavour, this full strength, low carbohydrate beer delivers a refreshingly clean and crisp finish.

Hahn Premium Light 2.7%

A superior tasting light beer, brewed using a combination of imported hops and Australian malt, this beer is low in alcohol but full of flavour.

Crown Lager 4.9%

One of Australia's most iconic brands, Crown Lager was first launched to celebrate the coronation of Queen Elizabeth II in 1953. Attention to detail in the brewing process helps create the creamy fruitiness, rich malty palate and crisp clean hop taste that makes this beer a favourite.

Pikes Oakbank (Clare Valley, SA) – 4.5%

A sparkling pilsner style of beer, it is fresh and very aromatic, displaying citrus and fruity notes derived from premium hop usage and complimented by high quality malted Australian Barley. It finishes clean and crisp with a hint of bitterness adding length and texture.

All Aussie Cider

Napoleone and Co Pear Cider “Cider by Winemakers” (Yarra Valley) 5.4%

This unique pear cider has been hand crafted using fresh Yarra Valley pears. Unmistakable pear aromas lead to a bright textural palate and a refreshing clean finish.

Hills Pear Cider (Adelaide Hills, SA) 5.2%

Made locally in the Adelaide Hills using only 100% fresh pear and without the addition of concentrates, flavouring and sugar, this cider is not too sweet & very refreshing with a crisp fizzy consistency, but with a deep, rich pear taste.

Lobo Cider (Adelaide Hills, SA) 5.7%

This cider is made from real Adelaide Hills apples and has a cloudy, unfiltered and full of apple character with a little fizz to finish.

Strongbow Original 4.5%

This cider is one of Australia’s most popular ciders and is particularly perfect because it is easy to drink and refreshing with a hint of acidity for a clean, crisp finish.

Pipsqueak (Fremantle, WA) 5.2%

Created from locally sourced fresh apple juice, Pipsqueak is light in colour, medium body, with a great lingering texture. A drink perfect for lazy afternoons!

Dirty Granny Apple Cider (Matlida Bay, WA) 5.5%

With 100% Australian apples, a rich and full flavour cider with a good balance of sweetness, acidity and crispness. The cider pours darker in colour with an almost dirty rustic appearance combined with a taste fresh and juicy just like that of a Granny Smith apple.
